# AKC's Canine Good Citizen® (CGC) Program Course



AKC's Canine Good Citizen® (CGC) Program is a certification program that is designed to reward dogs who have good manners at home and in the community. The CGC Program is a two-part program that stresses responsible pet ownership for owners and basic good manners for dogs. All dogs who pass the 10-step CGC test may receive a certificate from the American Kennel Club.

The CGC Program lays the foundation for other AKC activities such as obedience, agility, tracking, and performance events. As you work with your dog to teach the CGC skills, you'll discover the many benefits and joys of training your dog. Training will enhance the bond between you and your dog.

All dogs, including both purebred and mixed breed dogs are welcome to participate in the AKC's CGC Program. There is no age limit for the CGC test. A dog is never too old to be a good citizen. Puppies that have completed all immunizations and boosters may be tested, however, because we know that behavior and temperament can change over time, when puppies pass the CGC test, owners should have them re-tested as adults

**Cost:** \$55.00 for GPCDFA club members (in good standing) or \$85.00 non-club members. There is a \$25.00 charge for each additional dog for Handlers with more than one dog.

**Prerequisite:** None.

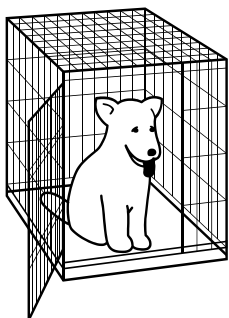
