Rally for Fun Obedience Course



This class introduces handlers to the sport of AKC Rally Obedience, but is not just for people who wish to compete. Dog and handler teams work through a course that has participants completing a variety of skills that range in difficulty from Novice to Excellent. This course will work on improving foundation skills including sit, down, stand, and heel, and incorporating more difficult skills like pivots, stays, fronts and finishes, backing up, and doing jumps.

This course is great opportunity to review and practice basic obedience! Rally For Fun will include some jump work and some off leash work when appropriate. Rally is a great opportunity for the over-zealous or excitable dogs to continue to build attention and focus on their handlers.

Cost: \$55.00 for GPCDFA club members (in good standing) or \$85.00 non-club members. There is a \$25.00 charge for each additional dog for Handlers with more than one dog.

Prerequisite: Dogs must have a CGC or completed a basic Obedience course or equivalent. Dogs should be familiar with basic obedience commands including heel, sit, down, stay, and come/front.

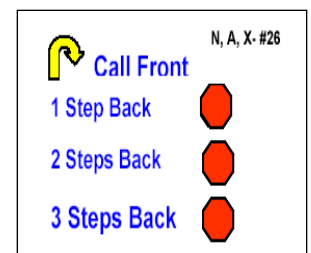
